

Getting started

The first step towards your Get Arty! session starts here: introducing the project with your pupils with a special assembly. We recommend running this assembly before the lesson if you can.

Get Arty! presentation

Use the Powerpoint presentation we have produced during your assembly. This introduces Mencap, Get Arty! and includes fun, engaging content to explain and visualise the concept. Look out for notes at the bottom of each slide, which include more information and questions to ask the pupils.

Key learning outcomes

After the presentation, talk about the benefits of Get Arty! listed below:

- * learning about art created by disabled people
- * understanding what a learning disability is
- * finding out what art means for people with a learning disability
- * reflecting on what makes people different from each other
- * becoming more accepting of difference, inside and outside of the classroom.

Describe what will happen next in the Get Arty! lesson
